Booking Terms and Conditions

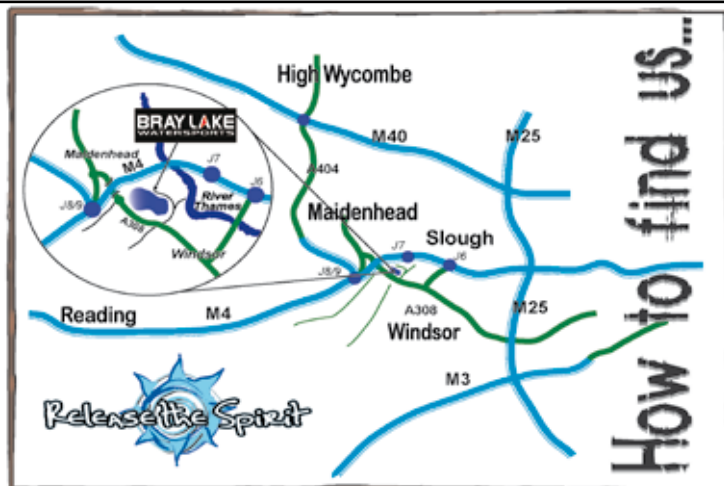
Customers are reminded that water sports participation involves an element of risk. Insurance against personal injury, accident or loss whilst undertaking a course or hiring any equipment is the responsibility of the participant. The Lake owners and operators will accept no liability for such injury, accident, damage or loss excepting liability for death or personal injury resulting from negligence attributable to and fault of the Lake owners and or operators.

Every precaution is taken to ensure the hygiene of our school and hire wetsuits, however, customers with known skin complaints which may be contagious are requested to contact the Centre in advance of the party. Participants should be in good health and be confident in the water. It is important, however, that you notify the Centre if a non-swimmer.

How to Find Us

Bray Lake from Reading

Leave the M4 at junction 8/9 and take the A308(M) towards Maidenhead. At the roundabout take the third exit which is sign posted the A308 to Windsor. Once on the A308 ignore the first sign post to Bray and pass under the motorway and carry straight on over the mini-roundabout. Continue on the A308, passing a Post Office on your left, be careful of the speed camera here, the limit is 40mph! About ½ mile past the Post Office on the left is Monkey Island lane, sign posted Bray Lake and Bray Marina. Turn left here, follow the lane past the marina on your right and you will come to our entrance on the left. Follow the road around to the Lake and you will find reception in the club



Bray Lake from London

Leave the M4 at Junction 6 and follow the A355 towards Windsor. Take the first turning off the dual carriageway and at the roundabout take the third exit sign posted the A308 to Maidenhead. Once on the A308 be careful of speed cameras by Windsor racecourse, the limit is 40mph! Once you get to the roundabout carry straight on and you will pass Oakley Court Hotel on your right and the Queens Head pub on your left. Just past the pub on the right is Monkey Island lane, sign posted Bray Lake and Bray Marina. Turn right here, follow the lane past the marina on your right and you will come to our entrance on the left. Follow the road around to the Lake and you will find reception in the club house.

What to bring on the day....

- Birthday Party Booking form if not already returned.
- Towel and swimming costume.
- Sun block and hat if appropriate.
- Waterproof jacket and warm clothing if appropriate.
- Pair of trainers you don't mind getting wet.
- Pair of old shorts to wear over the top of the wetsuit.
- Spare change if you wish to purchase refreshments from our Lake side cafe.

Parents - All you need to know!

Please read and complete the information overleaf. Tear off the consent form and return it to the parents organising the party. Please do not hesitate to contact the Centre if you would like further information.

Bray Lake has been teaching water sports for over 30 years and is one of most highly respected centres in the country. We openly encourage the participation of young people in water sports at all levels through our junior and schools programme, junior club activities and the sponsorship of local aspiring racers.

- **Centre Recognition.** The Centre is recognised by the Royal Yachting Association and British Canoe Union, and holds an 'Adventure Activities Licence' (AALA approval). It is required to have yearly inspections by these National Governing Bodies (NGB's) to ensure that it meets with industry standards. All areas of the operation are inspected with close attention given to health and safety, insurance, coaching standards, equipment quality and condition.
- **Staff.** All instruction at Bray Lake is provided by qualified RYA or BCU instructors. All of our staff undergo in-house training to ensure that health and safety issues specific to Bray Lake are covered. Our instructor / student ratios comply with NGB recommendations. All of our staff are first aid qualified, qualified powerboat drivers, and are in radio contact with base.
- **Buoyancy Aids, Wetsuits and Helmets.** Buoyancy aids are compulsory and are provided for all participants. They are fitted by our instructors to ensure correct size and usage. Wetsuits will be provided by the Centre for activities that involve regular immersion. The use of helmets will be at the discretion of the Senior Instructor on the day.
- **Safety Boats.** All groups, with the exception of kayaking and canoeing, will have coach boats assigned to them and a dedicated safety boat will be on stand by whilst groups are afloat.
- **Equipment.** All of our equipment is replaced on a regular basis and undergoes daily maintenance checks to ensure good safe working condition. All of our junior equipment is designed and chosen specifically to assist young people in learning new skills.
- **Water confidence.** All participants, including adults, involved in 'on water' activities must have a degree of water confidence. They do not have to be able to swim, our buoyancy aids provide more than adequate floatation, but they should be confident enough not to panic.
- **Valuables.** Please be aware that we do not accept any responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, valuables and personal belongings. All valuables should be left at Reception during the party, or ideally left at home.
