On-site accommodation is available to a limited number of instructors and overtime work is regularly available.

Due to the nature of the working environment and the inevitable contact with children, this role is subject to a satisfactory enhanced DBS check. Applications for this role must be eligible to work in the UK.

Key Responsibilities

- You will be self-motivated and team orientated – you will possess the ability to instruct and lead groups of children, young people and adults, maintaining a fun environment whilst delivering a structured course and continuously assessing risk.
- Preparing set up & clear down, ensuring correct and safe storage of kit whilst remaining vigilant for damages/safety breaches to ensure staff and student safety is paramount at all times.
- Assisting with general centre duties as requested to include; centre opening, greeting customers, maintaining professionalism around the centre (even when off duty), liaising with regulars & members to ensure a club environment is maintained.
- Enhance sales through suggesting additional courses, facilitate customer requirements through associative shop sales, and where possible drive customer affiliation through membership sales and customer referral.



- Support the Centre Manager with any centre and equipment end of day clean down, in addition to lake, building and ground maintenance work as required
- Adhere to the staff manual & centre regulations at all times
- Any other reasonable duties

Requirements

- Applicants must be over the age of 17 years
- Strong communications skills are essential, the applicant must be able to converse fluently with the centre team and their students.
- Must hold relevant & current qualification in dinghy sailing, to include a current First Aid qualification.
- Flexible approach to working hours – willingness to work overtime is a bonus.
